Escajadillo vecinos de la frontera de la Baja California residentes en el rancho de "Peate", cantidades de pesos que justamente me deben y que se comprueban y manifiestan en los documentos e instrucciones que entrego á mi Afioderado Don José Reinos; cuyas cantidades cobrará y persivirá judicial o extrajudicialmente como necesario fuere: obrando en estos particulares y sus incidencias con amplias facultades segun yo mismo lo hacia siendo presente, sin que por falta de cláusula, expresion o requisito que aqui no se contenga, deje de proceder, pues en tanto necesite doy por incertas. — Y si sobre los particulares asentados o sus incidencias se ofreciere con tienda de juicio, pueda comparecer y comparezca en los Tribunales superiores e inferiores de todos fueros que con derecho deba, incluso los de conciliacion; y en donde conenga haga pedimentos, requirimientos, citaciones, protestas, réplicas, alegaciones, oposiciones, contradicciones, ejecuciones, mejoras, prisiones, soltas, apartamientos, consentimientos, desistimientos, embargos, depósitos y desembargo de bienes, venta

trance y remate de ellos, de que pida y tome posesion, adjudicacion, amparo y lanzamiento: que defienda y continie, presente escritos y otros documentos, produzca testigos, tache y objeione los de contrario producidos, recuse, jure o se aparte, pida terminos o los renuncie, gane todo genero de despatchos que presente donde importen; y en caso necesario censuras con la regular protesta; oiga autos y sentencias, interlocutorias y definitivas, que consienta lo favorables y de lo adverso apela y suplique, siga su grado o se desista, y haga todos los demas actos, pedimentos, agencies y diligencias que judicial, o extrajudicialmente importen, pues para todo lo dicho, en anexo insidente y dependiente le confiero este poder amplio y no limitado, con facultad de enjuiciar, jurar, y substituir, revocar substitutos, y nombrar otros que a todos relevo en forma. 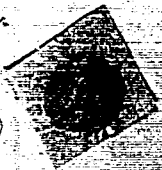

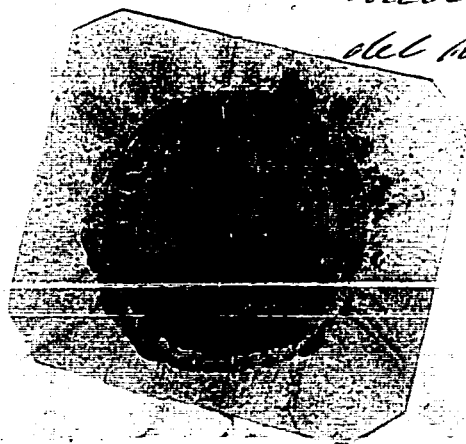

Mogart at New San Diego thirteen thousand three hundred and thirty two pounds of Barley for which he paid said Mogart at the rate four and one half cents per pound, and that that was the then current price of Barley - or that was the lowest price that he could purchase Barley in San Diego at that time
