we got it over half done, this canal will pay big. I can
sell my part at any time it is the best conducted
canal in the country and very rich Dry diggings, all I
would sell for it would be, to be with you, you must
have good machinery, I looked for you in San Francisco two
days I could not find you, I saw Old Parker in
San Francisco he told me where you lived I went there
you was gone and if you can give me any encourag
ement I am with you, Surely ^{we} could not forgetten me
I was carpenter ~~of~~ of the Empire State you was Engineer
as I stuck by her, I should stick by you the same
I come here to Placerville on a visit to see my friend
Hannibal Hollister he owns an interest in a saw
mill in the upper end of the town a week saw
me they also go in with with you if you aint got
any one engage he is a good fellow if you
come to Placerville you will please to see him
and what ever he says in regard to the operations

I shall agree to I am going to try town
