Directions for Opening the Case.

First cut the iron straps with a file when the case fastens on at the sides. Then remove the top part of the straps, then unscrew the tops and the ends which fasten into the top with a chisel cut the one screw in the top at one end and the nails which may be in the end piece fastening ^{into} the top.

Remove the cover, take out the dry goods on top. The key of the trunk you will find tied to a string of one of the pistols.
