RETURN THIS STATEMENT FOR PAYMENT

**Do Not Detach the Stub**

Rent, Postal or Express Money  
Orders,

Drafts, Checks, Stamps, etc., are not  
received.

The only time and place to correct valuation is  
before the Board of Equalization.

The Board of Equalization meets about the first  
Monday in April of each year.

IF YOUR PROPERTY IS NOT AS-  
SESSED TO YOU it is because you re-  
jected to make a return of it to the As-  
sessor. This must be done in January of  
each year.

DON'T FORGET YOUR PERSONAL  
TAX, when attached to your realty. Even  
if the latter is covered by mortgage it will  
be sold for that personal tax.

LECTOR.

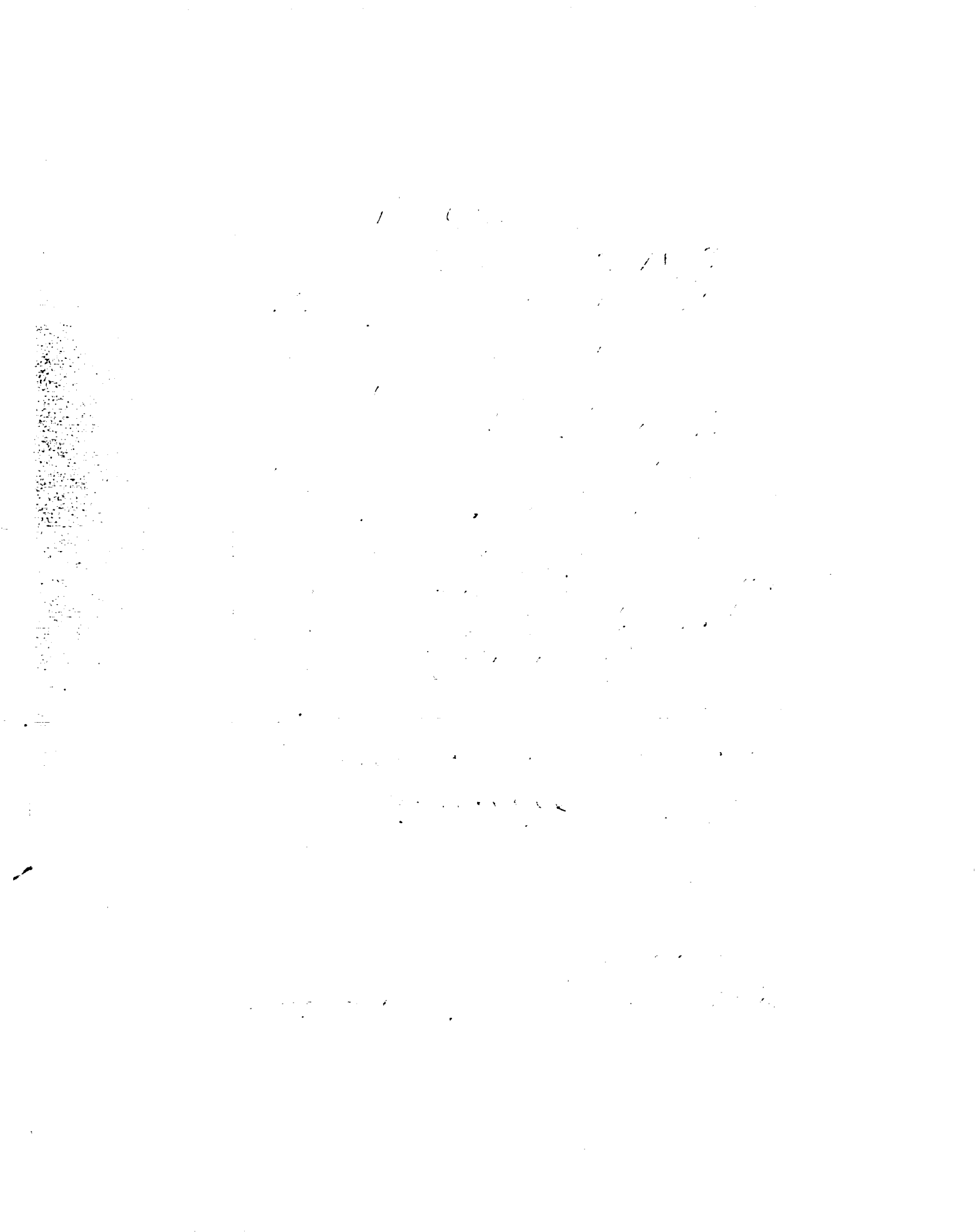
