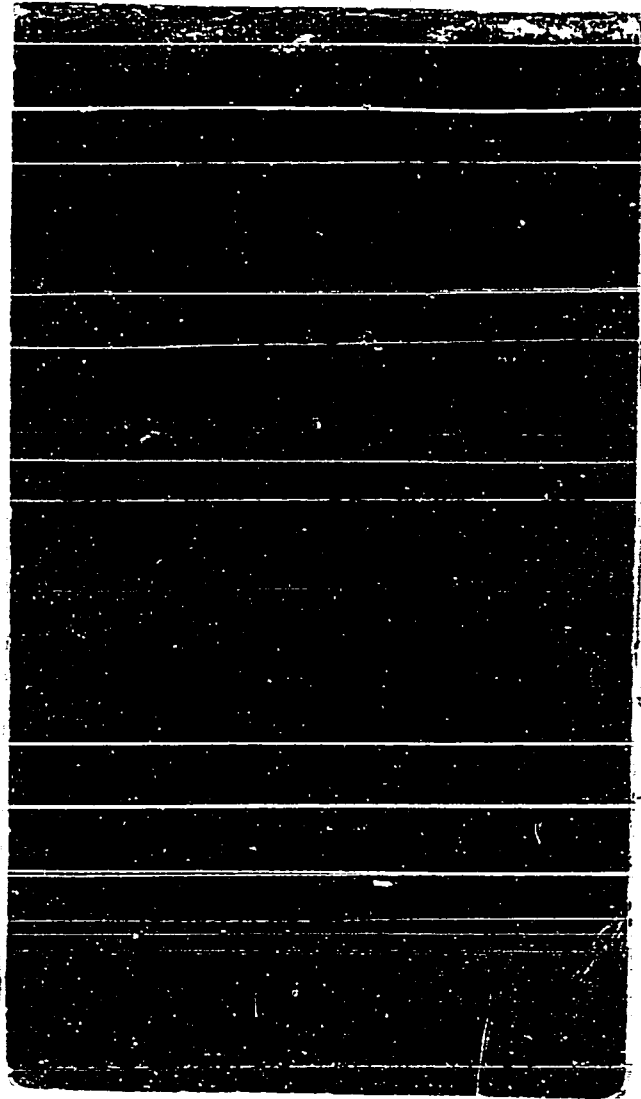

**BUSINESS LAW IN DAILY USE.**

- It is a fraud to conceal a fraud.
- Ignorance of the law excuses no one.
- The acts of one partner bind all the rest.
- A note or contract made with a minor or lunatic is void.
- An agreement without consideration is void.
- Principals are responsible for the acts of their agents.
- Checks or drafts must be presented for payment in reasonable time.
- Signatures made with lead pencil are good in law.
- A note made on Sunday is void, and contracts made on Sunday cannot be enforced.
- A note obtained by fraud or from a person in a state of intoxication cannot be collected.
- An indorsee has the right of action against all whose names were on the bill when he received it.
- Part payment of a debt which has passed the time of statutory limitation revives the whole debt.
- An indorser may prevent his own liability to be sued by writing "without recourse," or similar words.
- If the letter containing a protest of non-payment be put into the post office, any miscarriage does not affect the party giving notice.
- Each individual in a partnership is responsible for the whole amount of the debts of the firm, except in cases of special partnership.
- A note lost or stolen does not release the maker; he must prove it, if the consideration for which it was given and the amount can be proven.
- An oral agreement must be proved by evidence. A written agreement proves itself. The law prefers written to oral evidence because of its precision.

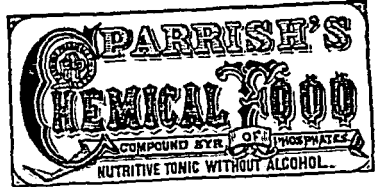
