

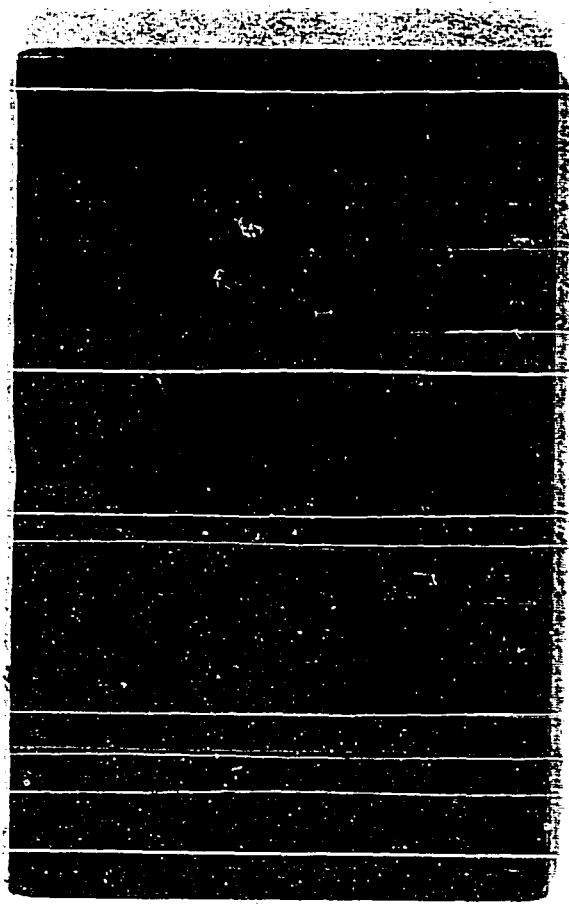

"Christmas Ridge" New Jersey
Take Passaic Ferry at
foot of Chambers, at N. W. J.,
and Erie R. R. cars at
Ferry house, New Jersey,
thence to Allendale, Pa.,
and take wagon or sleigh
to Christmas Ridge; dis-
tance, six miles, more or
less.

Spent Christmas day at
sleigh riding, and even-
ing at the First Congre-
gational Chapel at Park
Ridge, witnessing the Christ-
mas festivities, with my
winnies, and going in a
sleigh.

Next night after my
arrival, with going
with the girls, to a
Sunday School celebra-
tion, also in sleigh.
The Buttda family go
quiet and flies under
New Year, I went to
sleigh riding with my
cousin Dollie.

We have had a great
deal of snow here, over
two feet deep, with heavy
north-^{west} and blizzard
winds and very cold,
having few pleasant
days for sleigh riding.
All glad to see me.

To-day Jan. ^{30th 1777} 1777
I staid for Patterson
to see my Aunt Mary,
stayed a couple of nights
then returning to the
congregation city of
New York.

~~Staid at Chestnut~~
Bridge. Received word
a sister of my arrival
at Chestnut Ridge, in
the Starbuckham Democrat
and also a notice of
a "pious eagle" I made
at the chapel on Christ-
mas night, going to
the "cell house."

Splendid home alto-
gether, enjoy myself
nicely with the privilege
of coming again and
staying as long as I wish.

Must take on being
made on part of Peter
John, Thomas not expect-
ed we arrived at
Alondale one day too
soon, expecting them on
at that time, certainly his
time to come was the next
day and in consequence
we had to walk through
the snow a distance of
six miles through the
