The City of San Diego is reviewing potential changes to the Mills Act program as part of its Preservation and Progress initiative. Public feedback is critical to ensuring that historic preservation remains a priority and that affordability in historic neighborhoods is protected.

How to Take Action

 - **Protect the Mills Act** from unnecessary restrictions that would harm historic preservation and affordable homeownership.
 - **Recognize the Mills Act as a key affordable housing tool** that helps low- and middle-income residents stay in their homes.
 - **Avoid adding bureaucratic hurdles** that discourage participation and lead to displacement.
 - **Expand, rather than reduce, access to the program** to ensure more historic homes remain viable as Naturally Occurring Affordable Housing (NOAH).
