## President's Message



SOHO'S PRESIDENT, BILL CARTWRIGHT, IS PLANNING A VERY BUSY YEAR AHEAD FOR THE MEMBERSHIP. PLANS ARE NOW UNDERWAY TO MOVE THE CHRISTIAN HOUSE, WHICH LOCATED AT 1940 THIRD AVENUE, AND THE BURTON HOUSE, LOCATED AT 1970 THIRD AVENUE, TO HERITAGE PARK IN OLD TOWN. BOTH HOUSES ARE EXPECTED TO BE MOVED ON THE SAME DAY TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF HAVING THE POWER LINES LIFTED ONLY ONCE FOR THE TWO HOUSES.

NEGOTIATIONS ARE UNDER WAY NOW TO SECURE TWO OTHER BUILDINGS THAT WILL BE MOVED TO HERITAGE PARK, HOPEFULLY BY THE END OF 1975.

IF YOU HAVE BEEN BY HERITAGE PARK LATELY, YOU SHOULD HAVE NOTICED A PLEASANT CHANGE IN THE SCENERY THERE. THE PARK HAS BEEN LANDSCAPED, AND THE SHERMAN-GILBERT HOUSE IS NOW BEING RENOVATED.

IN ADDITION TO SAVING VICTORIAN BUILDINGS, SOHO WILL EXPAND ITS EDUCATIONAL ACT-IVITIES IN THE COMING YEAR, BY OFFERING CLASSES, AND PRODUCING A BOOK! BUT MORE ON THAT LATER.





#### HISTORIC NEIGHBORHOOD

THE CONCEPT OF THE HISTORIC NEIGHBORHOOD, AS BOUNDED BY FRONT, FIR, FIRST, AND GRAPE STREETS, WAS DEFEATED AT THE HISTORIC SITE BOARD MEETING ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 4TH, BY 75 PERCENT OF THE PROPERTY OWNERS INVOLVED. THE REASON GIVEN, WAS THE FEAR OF PROPERTY VALUE DEPRECIATION.

THERE ARE THREE PROPERTIES THAT WILL BE BROUGHT BEFORE THE BOARD FOR CON—SIDERATION AS HISTORIC SITES, AT THE NEXT BOARD MEETING IN NOVEMBER. THESE PROPERTIES ARE: 1929 FRONT ST. 136 WEST FIR, AND 126 AND 130 WEST FIR—TWO HOUSES ON ONE LAND PARCEL.
