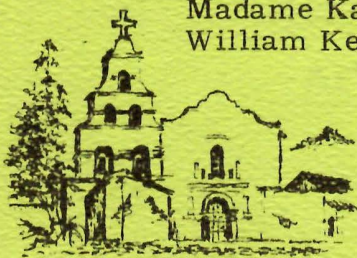

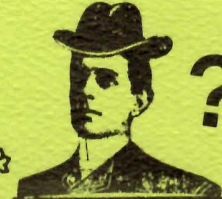
PHONE CHANGE

FROM THE BOARD ROOM

The Board of Directors of SOHO heard an appeal for continuing support from members of the San Diego Rowing Club. Attempts are still being made to preserve the building on site and to repair on-going damage to the pilings beneath. The Historic Site Board has reiterated the historicity of the building and SOHO has still pledged to back Rowing Club members in their struggle to stem the tide against demolition. Petitions are being circulated and a meeting with the City Council planned.

ANNOUNCING

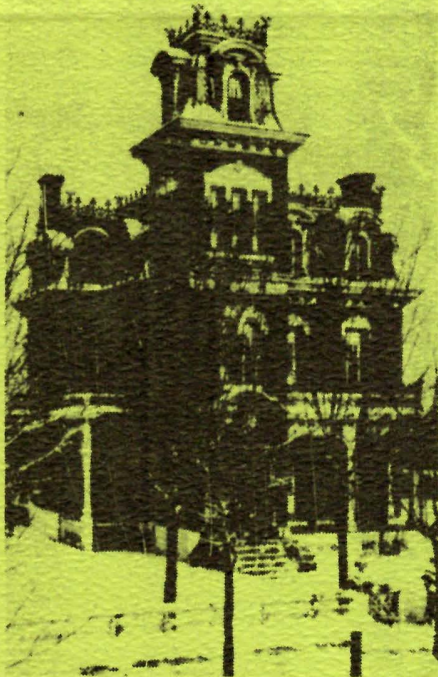
22nd ANNUAL SEMINAR FOR HISTORICAL ADMINISTRATION
May 31 - June 28, 1980
WILLIAMSBURG, VIRGINIA



This tuition-free four-week seminar, first held in 1959, is the best short course available in historical agency administration. It provides an intensive overview of administration for staff members already employed in private and public historical societies, museums, restoration and preservation projects, historic sites and parks. To qualify, applicants should have at least one year of graduate training in American history, art or architectural history or allied fields.
