

FROM THE BOARD ROOM

The Board of Directors of SOHO heard an appeal for continuing support from members of the San Diego Rowing Club. Attempts are still being made to preserve the building on site and to repair on-going damage to the pilings beneath. The Historic Site Board has reiterated the historicity of the building and SOHO has still pledged to back Rowing Club members in their struggle to stem the tide against demolition. Petitions are being circulated and a meeting with the City Council planned.

Lease arrangements on the Senlis Cottage, our future SOHO office and home in Heritage Park are still dragging on. Hopefully, by the end of the month all negotiations will be ironed out. Chuck Hellerich and Carol Lindemulder are meeting with the County Real Property Division in attempts to speed up a lengthy process.
